

ZEC S.P.A Website Privacy Policy (art. 13 legislative decree 196/2003)

This page provides an outline of the general management of this website, in reference to the treatment of personal data of its visitors. Aforementioned directions are taken by ZEC S.p.A as owner of the website and by Immagica Comunicazione S.r.L as website administrator.

This notice is provided according to art. 13 legislative decree 196/2003 – *Protection of Personal Data Policy* – to all users of this website, with direct access through address www.zecspa.com.

This notice applies to this website only, irrespectively of others eventually accessible through hyperlinks or randomly found.

This notice meets the *Recommendation 2/2001* of the *European Personal Data Protection Authorities*, dated 17th May 2001. The Group, formed in accordance to art. 29, regulation 95/46/CE, lays down minimum requisites for the on-line storage of personal data, method, time and source of the information accessible to the users from the data processor when reaching the website – reasons for accessing aside.

Data Processor

Identifiable or unidentifiable personal data can be processed after the visualization of the website. Responsibility imputable to ZEC S.p.A – headquarters in Via Lungolorno 11 – 43052 Colorno (Parma).

Location of Data Processing

Processing of data related to the services of this website takes place at ZEC S.p.A head offices. Company staff, solely entrusted with this task, is responsible for the management of all information. Operators may occasionally be charged with processing in case of maintenance. No data generated by the website is transferred to third parties.

Types of processed data

A – Navigation Data

IT systems and software procedures used for the functioning of this website, gather certain personal data, normally transmitted through internet protocols. Collection of these data does not aim to the identification of the concerned users but, given their source, could – through manipulation and information passed by third parties – possibly identify the navigating users.

These data includes IP addresses or domain names of the computers of the visiting users, URI addresses of the resources requested (Uniform Resource Identifier), time of the request, method used in forwarding the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in answer, the numeric code indicating the status of the server response (successful, error, etc.) as well as other parameters regarding the user's operating system and IT environment.

Such data are only to be used as to the collection of anonymous statistical information as per the use of the website, to monitor its correct functioning. All information are erased after processing. Data might be used for investigations in case of computer crimes against this website.

B – Data provided voluntarily by User

The acquisition of the sender's address and other personal information stated in the request, are implicitly gathered when the website data entry form is optionally, explicitly or voluntarily submitted.

Appropriate software manages all stored personal data in order to guarantee security and confidentiality, answer requests, supply the required services, send informational or commercial newsletters whether explicit consensus to this function was expressed.

Specific and short notices will be included or displayed on the website pages hosting the aforementioned on-demand services.

Cookies

No user personal data is intentionally acquired. No cookies are used to transmit personal information. No persistent cookies of any kind, for the tracking of users, are employed. Use of so-called session cookies (only temporarily stored on the user's computer and deleted when the browser closes) is strictly limited to the transmission of the session identification data (random numbers generated by the website server) required for an efficient and secure exploration.

Session cookies used by this website prevent the need for other IT systems potentially threatening to the user's privacy and do not allow for the collection of personal data identifying the user.

Directions for use

Personal data is processed by means of an automated system for the time strictly necessary to its collection and fulfillment of the task for which it was gathered.

Such measures are taken in order to prevent data losses, illicit or incorrect uses, and unauthorized accesses.

Facultative nature of personal data transmission

Beside what already specified for navigation data, every user is free to provide one's personal information as requested on the specific contact form displayed on the website. Failure to do so may result in the inability to obtain the requested information.

Rights of the individual concerned

Individuals referred to by the personal data collected – as per the methods above delineated – have the right, at any time, to get confirmation of the existence of the aforementioned data, to be informed on their content and origin, to check their accuracy or request for addition, updating or correction (as specified by art. 7 legislative decree 196/2003).

The individuals concerned also have the right to request for the data to be deleted or rendered anonymous or to block all retained information in case of violation of the law, or to oppose, with legitimate reasons, to their processing.
